DIRECTIONS (Follow REHAB Signs)

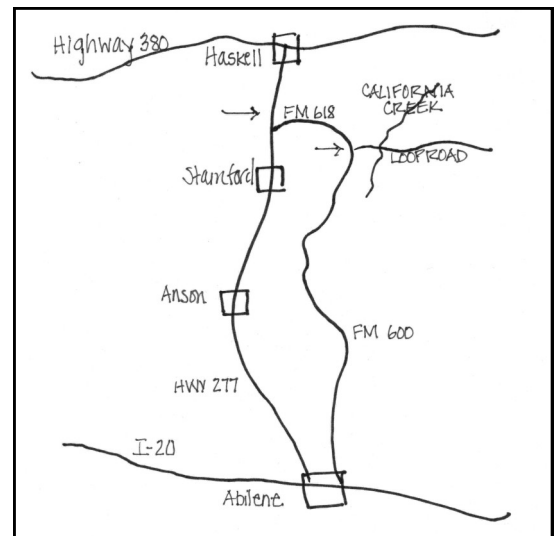
From Abilene: North on FM 600 (Exit 286-C off I-20). Travel North on FM 600 approximately 42 miles to Loop Road. This will take you through Avoca where FM 600 merges with FM 1636 for approximately 1/4 mile. From this point, continue on FM 600 North for 14 1/2 miles to Loop Road. Turn East on Loop Road and travel 8 1/2 miles to camp site OR travel North on US 277 through Anson and Stamford and turn East on FM 618. Travel East on FM 618 until it merges into FM 600 South (6 miles). Continue on FM 600 South to Loop Road (4 miles). Turn East on Loop Road and go 8 1/2 miles to camp. Follow REHAB signs.

From Haskell: Take US 277 South 9 miles to FM 618. Travel East on FM 618 until it merges into FM 600 South (6 miles). Turn East on Loop Road and go 8 1/2 miles to camp. Follow REHAB signs.

From Lubbock: Travel South on US 84 to Post. Turn East on US 380 to Haskell. Follow directions from Haskell.

From San Angelo: North to Abilene. Follow Abilene directions.

From Fort Worth: East on I-20 to Abilene. Follow Abilene directions.
